## RULES

An adverb can compare two or more actions.

Amy jumped higher than Lauren.

Amy jumped highest of all.

Add -er to a short adverb to compare two actions. Add -est to compare more than two actions.

Amy ran fast.

She ran faster than her teammate.

She ran fastest of all the women in the race.
