Language Key

We use would to talk about an imaginary situation. This situation could happen in the present or in the future, but it could also not happen at all. Example:

I would call up all my friends to help in an emergency.

Would can be used in a question or in a statement. Examples:

A: Would you do something about it, or would you wait for somebody else to organize people?

B: I wouldn't wait for anyone else to organize people.

Speaker A uses would in a question. Speaker B uses would in a statement that answers the question.






