

### Language Key

We use **would** to talk about an imaginary situation. This situation could happen in the present or in the future, but it could also not happen at all.

Example:

I *would* call up all my friends to help in an emergency.

**Would** can be used in a question or in a statement.

Examples:

A: *Would* you do something about it, or *would* you wait for somebody else to organize people?

B: I *wouldn't* wait for anyone else to organize people.

Speaker A uses **would** in a question. Speaker B uses **would** in a statement that answers the question.


