## Using HOPE and WISH to talk about the Future

### READ:

Use	<b>Hope</b> is used to talk about events that are likely.	<b>Wish</b> is used to talk about things that are not likely (unlikely)
grammar	I hope + present tense She hopes + will base verb  *They hope + can + base verb *can expresses ability or choice	He wishes + were verb+ing to base verb We wish + past tense I wish + would base verb *They wish + could base verb *could expresses ability or choice.
