

Present Continuous - Spelling rules

1. Match the spelling rules for the verbs ending in **-ing**



- 1) If the verb ends in **-ee...**
- 2) If the verb ends in **-ie...**
- 3) We don't double **the final consonant...**
- 4) If the verb ends in **vowel + a consonant...**
- 5) If the verbs ends in **-e...**
- 6) If the verb ends in **-y...**
- 7) If the verb has **more than two syllables** and the **stress isn't** on the last syllable...



A) We drop the **-e** and **add -ing**: *dance* → *dancing*



B) If the verb ends in **w / x / y**: *fix* → *fixing*



C) We **add -ing**: *see* → *seeing*



D) We **double the last consonant** and **add -ing**: *get* → *getting*



E) We **write -ying**: *study* → *studying*



F) We **don't double** the last consonant: *visit* → *visiting*



G) We **change it to -ying**: *lie* → *lying*
