Rule 1: When the adjective ends with a vowel just before the last letter being a consonant you must double the last letter and add “er” or “est” to its end.

Rule 2: When the adjectives end with letter ‘e’ you only add “r” or “st” to its end.

Rule 3: When the adjective ends with the letter ‘y’ we change the ‘y’ into ‘i’ and then add “er” or “est”
