nouns are used to name special or specific things. We always use a capital letter for proper nouns.

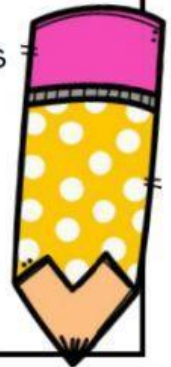
Examples: James, March, America.
