A A downward movement of a mass of rock, earth, or artificial fill on a slope.

B A rising and overflowing of a body of water especially onto normally dry land.

C A shaking or trembling of the earth that is volcanic or tectonic in origin.

D A tropical cyclone with strong winds of over 64 km per hour but less than hurricane intensity.

E A storm accompanied by lightning and thunder.

F A tropical cyclone with winds of 118 km per hour or greater that is usually accompanied by rain, thunder and lightning.

G A period of unusually hot weather.

H A sweeping and destructive large fire especially in the wilderness or a rural area.
