


COMPARATIVES



When we compare two things or people we add **-ER THAN** to a short adjective.

Example: short + er

Luke is short.

Luke is shorter er than Tim.

When we compare two things or people we add **MORE + ADJ + THAN** to a long adjective.

Example: intelligent

Susie is intelligent.

Susie is more intelligent than Luke.

A lizard is (beautiful) than a mouse.


