Consonate+ vocal+ consonante	Se duplica la última consonante Y luego se agrega: -ED	Stop/ Stopped	Travel/ travelled
Termina en "e"	Se agrega: -D	Live/ Lived	Like/ Liked
Termina en VOCAL + "Y"	Se agrega: -ED	Play/ Played	Stay/ Stayed
Termina en CONSONANTE + "Y"	Se elimina la Y, se reemplaza por "i" Y luego se agrega: -ED	Study/ Studied	Tidy/ Tidied
Para el resto de los casos...	Se agrega: -ED	Cook/ Cooked	Visit/ Visited
