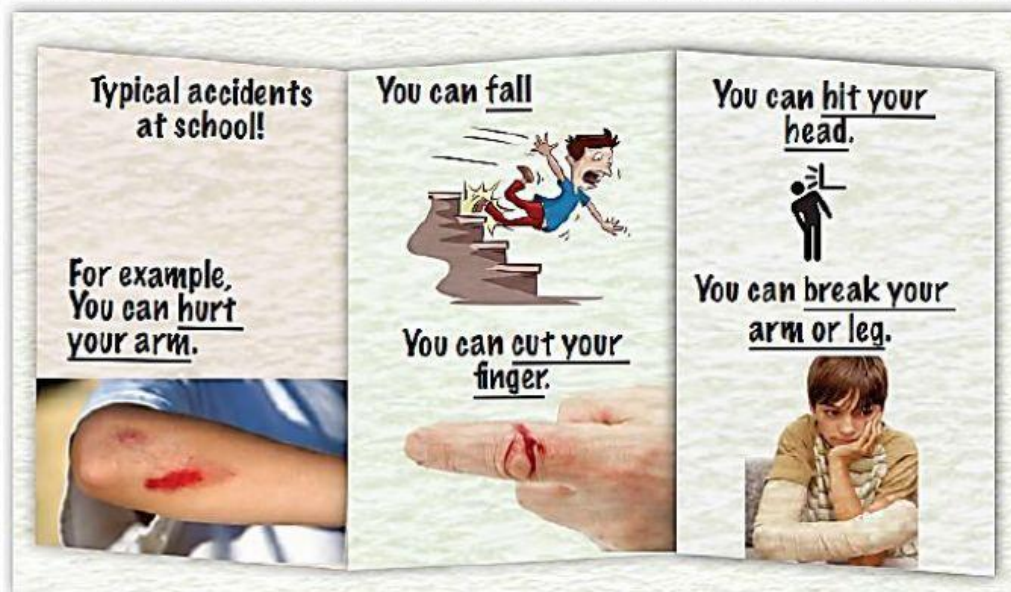


1 This is a report about accidents at school
