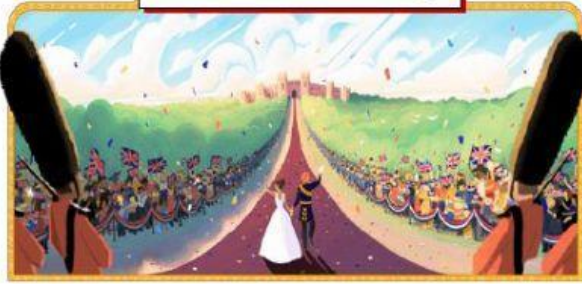


When Harry Married Meghan
