



Object Pronouns

Un pronoun es una palabra que sustituye a un noun (sustantivo) en una oración. Los **object pronouns** son palabras que sustituyen a los **object nouns** en las oraciones. Normalmente los encontraremos **después del verbo**.

Ejemplo:

Sam ate the chocolate fast.

Sam ate it fast.

The boys talk to the teacher.

The boys talk to her.

It	The cat, a chair, a dog, the school	it
She	Mary, Claire, Paula, the lady, my mother, a girl	her
He	Lucas, Tom, Carlos, Sergio, the boy, my father	him
