DOS FORMAS: WAS – WERE

WAS	WERE
I (yo), SHE (ella), HE (él), IT (eso/a)	YOU (vos, ustedes), WE (nosotros/as), THEY (ellos/as)

- ✓ I **WAS** A STUDENT (YO ERA ESTUDIANTE)
- ✓ SHE **WAS** A TEACHER (ELLA ERA UNA MAESTRA)
- ✓ THEY **WERE** MY CLASSMATES (ELLOS ERAN MIS COMPAÑEROS)
- ✓ YOU **WERE** MY FRIEND (VOS ERAS MI AMIGO)

NEGATIVE FORM:

WASN' T – WEREN' T

- ✓ I **WASN' T** A STUDENT (YO NO ERA ESTUDIANTE)
- ✓ SHE **WASN' T** A TEACHER (ELLA NO ERA UNA MAESTRA)
- ✓ THEY **WEREN' T** MY CLASSMATES (ELLOS NO ERAN MIS COMPAÑEROS)
- ✓ YOU **WEREN' T** MY FRIEND (VOS NO ERAS MI AMIGO)

## VERBO "HABER" IN THE PAST

### DOS FORMAS: THERE WAS – THERE WERE

THERE WAS	THERE WERE
<b>SINGULAR</b>  - There <u>was</u> a cat in my house. (Había un gato en mi casa)  - There <u>wasn't</u> a cat in my house (No había un gato en mi casa)	<b>PLURAL</b>  - There <u>were</u> two cats in my house (Había dos gatos en mi casa)  - There <u>weren't</u> two cats in my house (No había dos gatos en mi casa)
