entrance, and then the last few blocks <sup>(6)</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ (move) into the igloo through  
the entrance and they <sup>(7)</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ (lift) up to form the roof. Finally, the spaces  
between the blocks <sup>(8)</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ (fill) with snow.
