



Colombia Political administration

For its administration, Colombian territory is divided in departments, and at the same time these departments are divided in municipalities.

The departments are administrated by, a Governor

Governor Functions:

- The governor should direct and coordinate the administrative action of the department.
- should enforce the laws

The municipalities are divided in urban and rural. Urban are divided in corregimientos and veredas. Rural is divided in communes and neighborhoods

The President.

The president of the republic is the head of state, head of government and supreme administrative authority of the country.



The basic units of political administration of Colombia are the municipalities that are governed by a mayor and a city council, elected by popular vote.

Mayor

It is the highest governing authority in a municipality.

City Council

exerts political control in municipal administration and study projects.

Corregimientos and communes are governed by a Local Action Board its abbreviation in Spanish (JAL) and the neighborhoods and veredas are governed by a Community Action Board its abbreviation in Spanish (JAC)
