STARTS WITH LOW-LEVEL TEST ITEMS AND BECOME GRADUALLY MORE DIFFICULT TO CORRESPOND TO COURSE SEQUENCE.

A SIMPLE SPELLING TEST HIGHLY FOCUSED ON ORTHOGRAPHY

TRUE OR FALSE

A WRITING TEST THAT REQUIRES AN EXAMINER'S OPINION ON THE LEVEL OF THE WRITING.

IN TESOL FOR SPEAKING: INTERVIEWS AND PRESENTATIONS, FOR WRITING: ESSAY QUESTIONS.

DETERMINES WHAT AREAS OF LANGUAGE NEED TO BE IN THE SYLLABUS

THE LEARNERS HAVE FINISHED UNITS 1 - 4 OF A COURSEBOOK AND THE TEACHER NOW GIVES THEM A TEST FROM THE TEACHER'S BOOK BASED ON WHAT THEY HAVE LEARNT FROM THESE UNITS.

THE EXTENT TO WHICH INTERPRETATIONS OF TEST RESULTS ARE APPROPRIATE, GIVEN THE PURPOSE OF THE TEST.

THE TEST IS EASY TO DESIGN, EASY TO ADMINISTER AND EASY TO SCORE.

A WRONG ANSWER IN A MULTIPLE-CHOICE TEST THAT IS SIMILAR TO THE CORRECT ANSWER.

THE RESULT THAT A TESTING PRACTICE MAY HAVE ON TEACHING A PARTICULAR PROGRAM OR LESSON PLANNING.
