

# PRESENT SIMPLE

**PRESENT SIMPLE** para **I** (yo), **You** (tú), **We** (nosotros), **They** (vosotros):

## Affirmative:

I **eat** macaroni  
You **eat** macaroni  
We **eat** macaroni  
They **eat** macaroni

## Negative:

I **don't eat** macaroni  
You **don't eat** macaroni  
We **don't eat** macaroni  
They **don't eat** macaroni

## Interrogative:

**Do** I **eat** macaroni?  
**Do** you **eat** macaroni?  
**Do** we **eat** macaroni?  
**Do** they **eat** macaroni?

I/You/We/They

## PRESENT SIMPLE para **She** (ella), **He** (él), **It**

(para animal/cosa):

### Affirmative:

She **eats** macaroni  
He **eats** macaroni  
It **eats** macaroni

### Negative:

She **doesn't eat** macaroni  
He **doesn't eat** macaroni  
It **doesn't eat** macaroni

### Interrogative:

**Does** she **eat** macaroni?  
**Does** he **eat** macaroni?  
**Does** it **eat** macaroni
