### Zero Conditional Exercise

**ZERO**  
conditional

If you stand in the rain, you get wet.  
If you heat ice, it melts.

**PRESENT SIMPLE** + **PRESENT SIMPLE**

**USES:** Facts which are generally true or scientific facts  
The condition always has the same result

1. When you \_\_\_\_\_ (break) the law, you \_\_\_\_\_ (get) punished.
2. If you \_\_\_\_\_ (be) nice to people, they \_\_\_\_\_ (be) nice to you.
3. When you \_\_\_\_\_ (mix) yellow and blue, you \_\_\_\_\_ (get) green.
4. I \_\_\_\_\_ (not walk) alone in the park when it \_\_\_\_\_ (get) dark.
5. If you \_\_\_\_\_ (study), you \_\_\_\_\_ (get) good results.
6. If the car \_\_\_\_\_ (break), I \_\_\_\_\_ (take) it to the mechanic.

### First Conditional Exercise

**FIRST**  
conditional

If it rains, we will cancel the trip.  
If you study, you will pass the exam.

**PRESENT SIMPLE** + **WILL / WON'T + VERB**

**USES:** A possible situation in the future  
Predicting a likely result in the future (if the condition happens)

1. If I \_\_\_\_\_ (go) out tonight, I \_\_\_\_\_ (go) to the cinema.
2. If we \_\_\_\_\_ (not / see) each other tomorrow, we \_\_\_\_\_ (see) each other next week.
3. If he \_\_\_\_\_ (come), I \_\_\_\_\_ (be) surprised.
4. I \_\_\_\_\_ (buy) a new dress if I \_\_\_\_\_ (have) enough money.
5. We \_\_\_\_\_ (be) late if we \_\_\_\_\_ (not / hurry).
6. She \_\_\_\_\_ (take) a taxi if it \_\_\_\_\_ (rain).

## Second Conditional Exercise

### SECOND conditional

If I won the lottery, I would travel a lot.  
If they sold their house, they would be rich.

PAST SIMPLE

+

WOULD + VERB

USES: Hypothetical or unlikely situations  
Unreal or improbable situation now or in the future

1. If I (win) \_\_\_\_\_ a million dollars, I (put) \_\_\_\_\_ it all in a bank.
2. Jane (have) \_\_\_\_\_ more friends if she (be) \_\_\_\_\_ more easy-going.
3. If John (not work) \_\_\_\_\_ late last night, he (get up) \_\_\_\_\_ on time in the morning.
4. If you (lock) \_\_\_\_\_ the car, they (not steal) \_\_\_\_\_ it.
5. The room (look) \_\_\_\_\_ much better if you (paint) \_\_\_\_\_ it yellow.
6. I (enjoy) \_\_\_\_\_ the concert more if there (not be) \_\_\_\_\_ so many people.
