Day 12- Verbs in French

Être (TO BE)

Singular		Plural	
 Je suis	I am	 Nous sommes	We are
 Tu es	You are	 Vous êtes	You are (to adults and several people)
 Il est	He is/It is	 Ils sont	They are (masculine)
 Elle est	She is/ It is	 Elles sont	They are (feminine)

Example:

1. 'I'm a doctor': **Je suis médecin.** 🇫🇷
2. You're a student: **Tu es étudiant.** 🇫🇷
3. He is an engineer: **Il est ingénieur.** 🇫🇷
4. She is a doctor: **Elle est médecin.** 🇫🇷
5. We are tired: **Nous sommes fatigués.** 🇫🇷
6. You have arrived: **Vous êtes arrivés. (pl.)** 🇫🇷
7. They are happy: **Ils sont contents. (pl.)** 🇫🇷
8. They (the women) are happy.: **Elles sont contentes. (pl.)** 🇫🇷

Note:

We need to add "s" to a verb in the plural form.

If the verb is in plural and feminine form, you need to add 's' (plural) and 'e' (feminine).

Avoir (to have)

Singular		Plural	
J'ai 	I have	 Nous avons	We have
Tu as 	You have	 Vous avez	You have (to elder)
 Il a	He has/ It has	 Ils ont	They have (mas.)
 Elle a	She has/ It has	 Elles ont	They have (fem.)
Note: “je” becomes [J'] before vowels.			

Example:

1. I have a car.: ***J'ai une voiture.*** 
2. You have a red car: ***Tu as un stylo rouge.*** 
3. He has a blue car: ***Il a une voiture bleue.*** 
4. She has one brother: ***Elle a un frère.*** 
5. We have a car: ***Nous avons une voiture.*** 
6. You have a chocolate: ***Vous avez un chocolat.*** 
7. They (boys) have green pens. : ***Ils ont des stylos verts.*** 
8. They (women) have green eyes.: ***Elles ont les yeux verts.*** 

Aimer (to like)

Singular		Plural	
 j'aime	I like	 Nous aimons	We like
 Tu aimes	You like	Vous aimez 	You like
Il aime 	He likes	Ils aiment 	They like (mas.)
Elle aime 	She likes	Elles aiment 	They like (fem.)

Example:

- I like chocolate.: ***J'aime le chocolat.*** 
- You like Paris: ***Tu aimes paris.*** 
- He likes orange.: ***Il aime l'orange.*** 
- She likes strawberry.: ***Elle aime la fraise.*** 
- We like chocolates: ***Nous aimons les chocolats.*** 
- You like a book.: ***Vous aimez le livre.*** 
- They (men) like apples: ***Ils aiment les pommes.*** 
- They (women) like cherry.: ***Elles aiment les cerises.*** 

Some other verbs:

Adorer- to adore

He loves dancing.

Il adore danser. 

Détester- to hate

She hates garlic.

Elle déteste l'ail 

Parler- to speak

I speak French.

Je parle français 

Regarder- to look at

I'm watching TV.

Je regarde la
télévision. 

Écouter – to listen to

I'm listening to
music.

J'écoute de la
musique.
