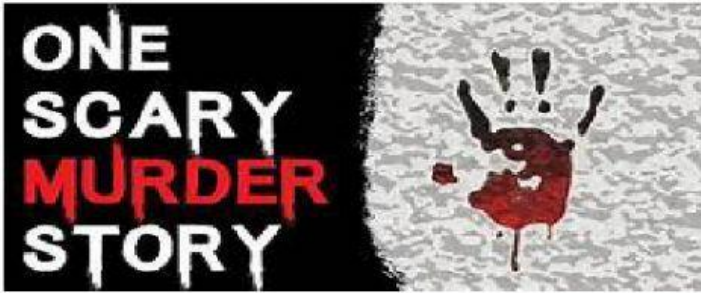


LISTENING ACTIVITY – part 1
