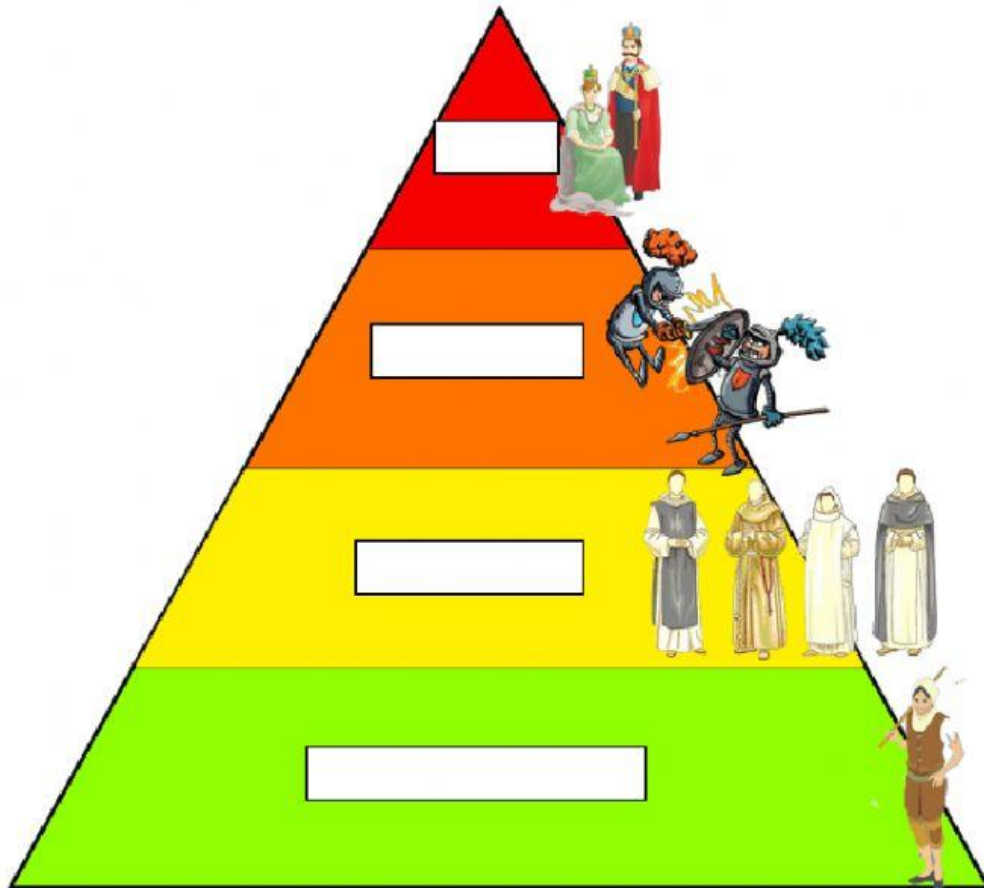


MIDDLE AGES
