DESERTS



Deserts are the driest places on Earth—they get very little rain a year. Sometimes it doesn't rain on a desert for many years. They can be covered in sand, stones, or rocks. In general, they are extremely hot in the day, but they can get cold at night.

There are deserts in Australia, Asia, Africa, and North and South America, like the Atacama Desert in the North of Chile.

If you think nothing can live in a desert, you are wrong! It's difficult for trees to grow, but many deserts have lots of plants and animals that have adapted to live with little water. Small plants and bushes can grow in the desert. Desert plants have to survive with no rain for many years. They store water inside them to stay alive. Many desert animals are nocturnal. It's colder and more comfortable for animals at night. Camels, scorpions, lizards, and many different insects live in deserts.
