AT - ON - IN

PREPOSITIONS OF TIME

AT + Specific Time

- I get up **at** 7 o'clock.

- The movie starts **at** 8.30.

- They sing carols **at** Christmas.

- Come and visit us **at** Thanksgiving.



AT + Holiday Period

ON + Days

- I will visit you **on** Wednesday.

- Where were you **on** Friday?

ON + Dates

- His birthday is **on** March 27th.

- The exam is **on** the 16th.

IN + Months

- My birthday is **in** January.

- I'm going on vacation **in** August.

IN + Years

- Shakespeare was born **in** 1564.

- The Titanic sank **in** 1912.

IN + the + Decade

- Life was difficult **in** the 1940s.

- There were many hippies **in** the '60s.

IN + the + Century

- We are living **in** the 21st century.

- It was built **in** the sixth century.
