and / or / but

- It is used to join two parts of the sentence.
- Examples: and, or, but

Conjunctions	Uses	Examples
and	It is used to connect two ideas.	(idea) and (idea) • I've got a sister and two brothers.
or	It is used to offer a choice.	(choice) or (choice) • Do you like ice cream or chocolate?
but	It is used to connect ideas that are contrast.	(idea) but (idea) • I love fruit but I am allergic to strawberries. • He is fat but he can run fast.
