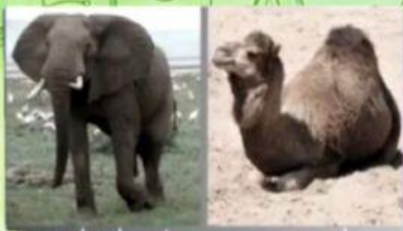

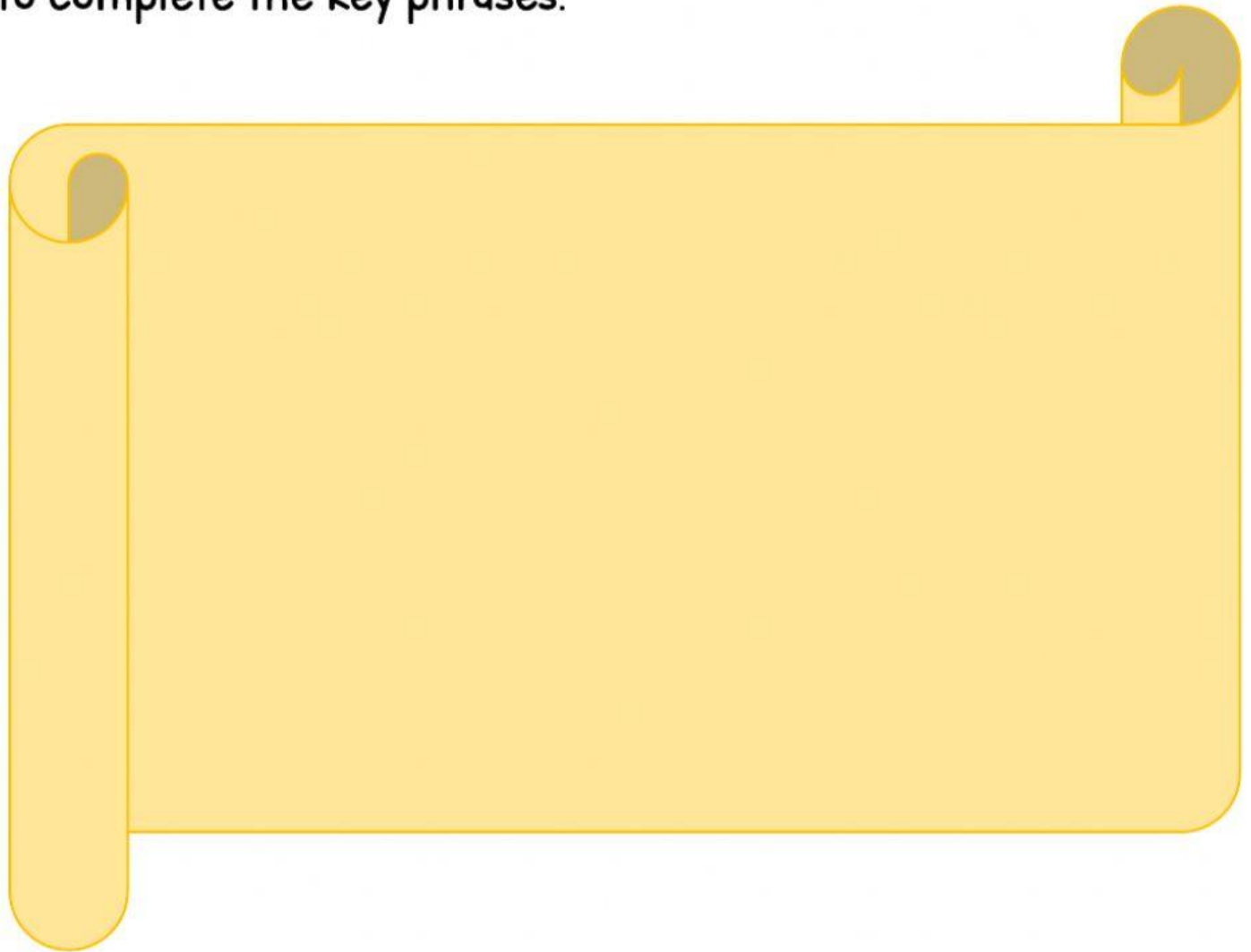

Look at the close up pictures of these animals. Can you guess which animal they are?

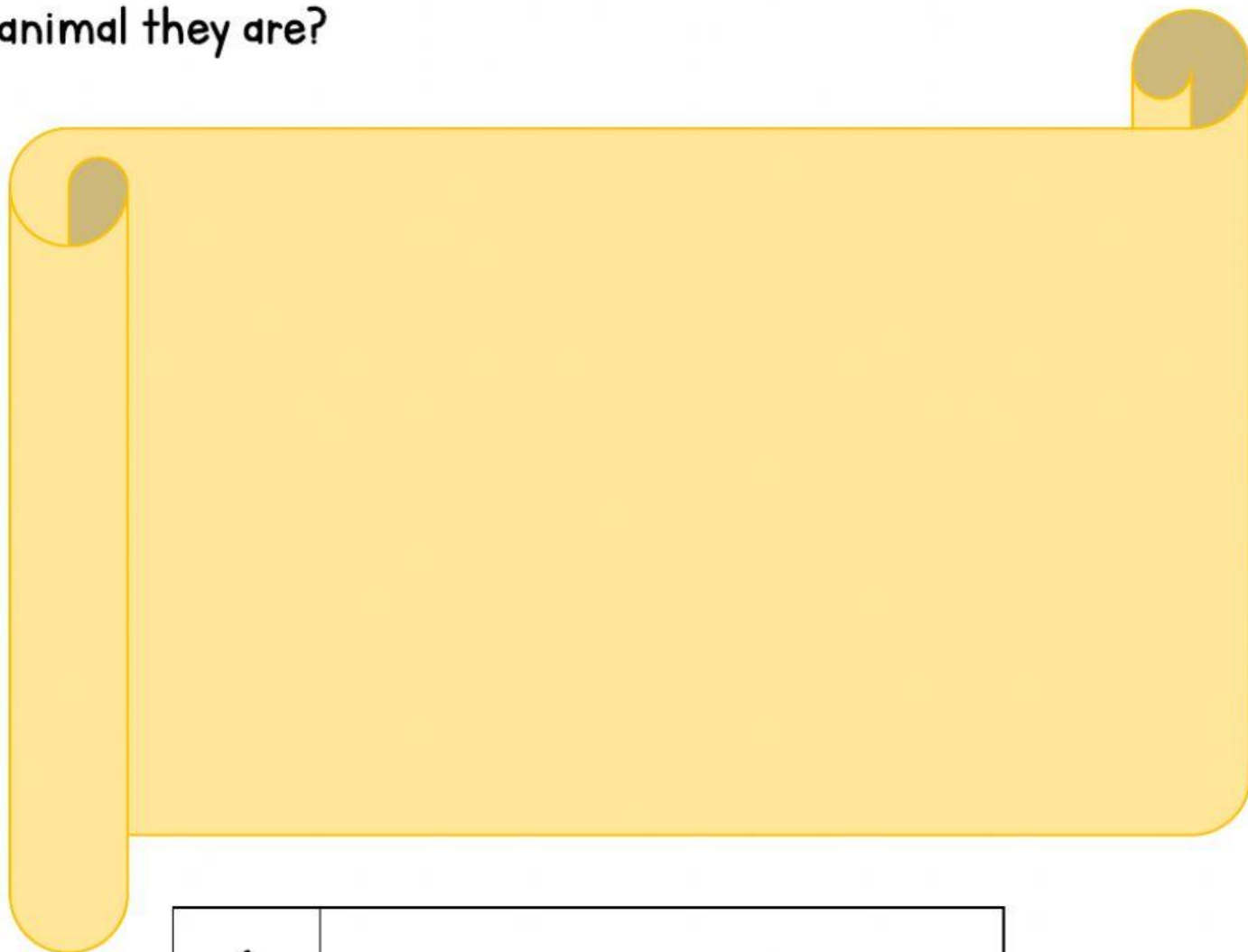
