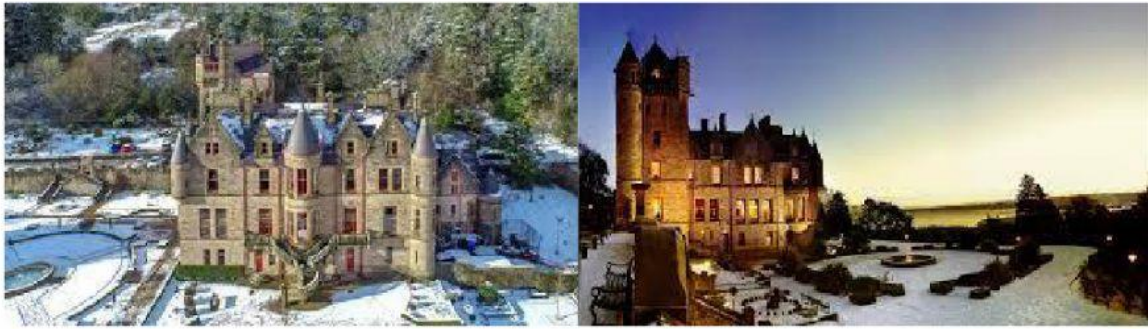


Belfast Castle
