

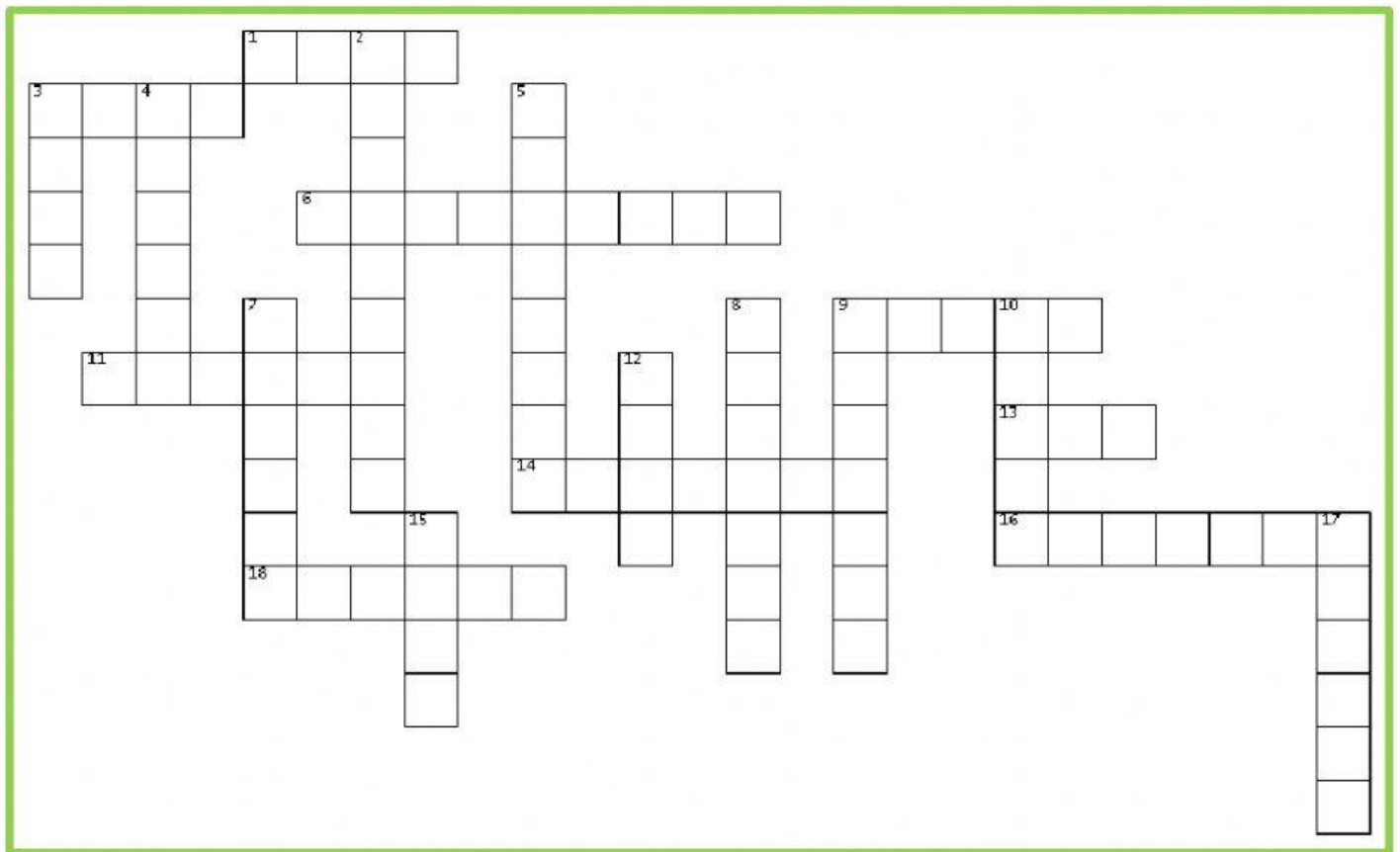

1 A stiff, sticky fine-grained earth, typically yellow, red, or bluish-gray in color and often forming an impermeable layer in the soil.

- 3 Metal drawn out into the form of a thin flexible thread or rod.
- 6 A small container, typically with sloping sides and made from plastic or earthenware, used for growing a plant in.
- 9 A sturdy item of footwear covering the foot, the ankle, and sometimes the leg below the knee.
- 11 The positively charged particles which are present in the nucleus of a hydrogen atom.
- 13 A floor covering of thick woven material or animal skin, typically not extending over the entire floor.
- 14 A subatomic particle of about the same mass as a proton but without an electric charge.
- 16 A length or square of fabric worn around the neck or head.
- 18 A soft white fibrous substance that surrounds the seeds of a tropical and subtropical plant and is used as textile fiber and thread for sewing.

- 2 A device or piece of equipment designed to perform a specific task, typically a domestic one.
- 3 The fine, soft curly or wavy hair forming the coat of a sheep, goat, or similar animal.
- 4 A tough elastic polymeric substance made from the latex of a tropical plant or synthetically.
- 5 An elementary particle that has a negative charge and is a constituent of all atoms.
- 7 An imbalance of electric charges within or on the surface of a material.
- 8 In all parts; taken as a whole.

9 A large piece of woolen or similar material used as a bed covering or other covering for warmth.

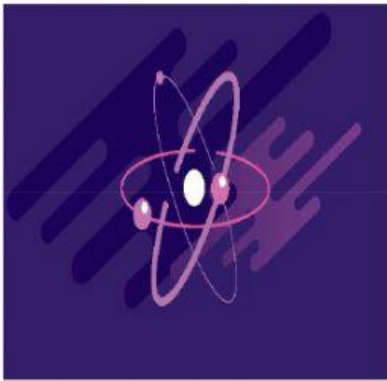
10 A rubber covering, typically inflated or surrounding an inflated inner tube, placed around a wheel to form a flexible contact with the road.

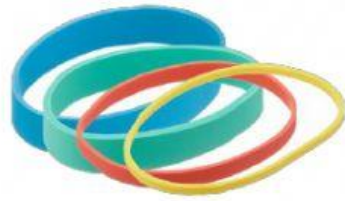
