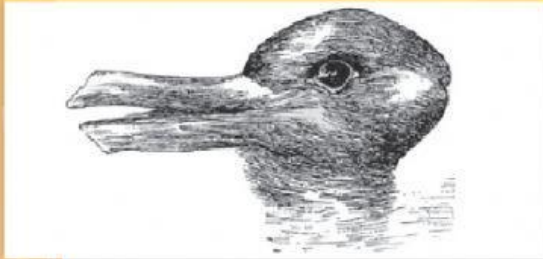

Verbs of Perception

We use a **verb** + **adjective** or a **verb** + **like** + **noun** to say how we perceive something:
It **looks** strange. It **looks like** a bird.
It **sounds** beautiful. It **sounds like** bells.
It's sweet. It's **like** candy.

We can also use **be**, **taste**, **feel** and **smell** with this pattern.
