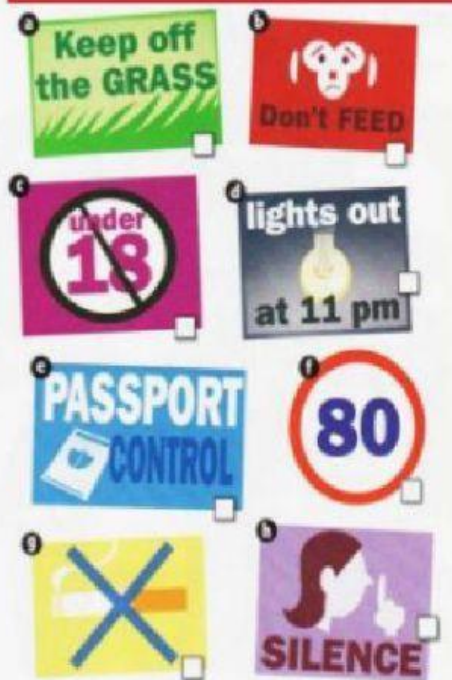


Must or Mustn't?
