

SENTENCE STRUCTURES

ACTIVITY 1: Match the description of each sentence structure.

SIMPLE SENTENCE

contains 1 independent clause and 1 or more dependent clauses. Dependent clause begins with a subordinating conjunction.

COMPOUND SENTENCE

is also called independent clause. It contains of subject and predicate.

COMPLEX SENTENCE

contains 2 or more independent clauses. Clauses are joined by a coordinating conjunction.

Nicole likes popular songs, but I prefer classical music.

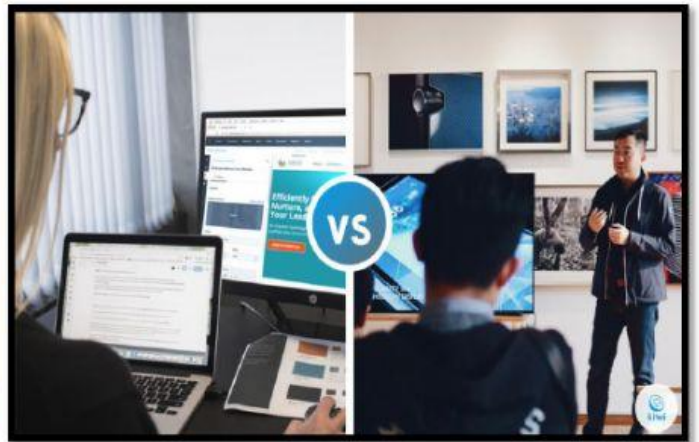
Wearing a mask decreases the spread of the virus.
