or the **SHORT FORM** of the verb to be (he's – he isn't) ✓

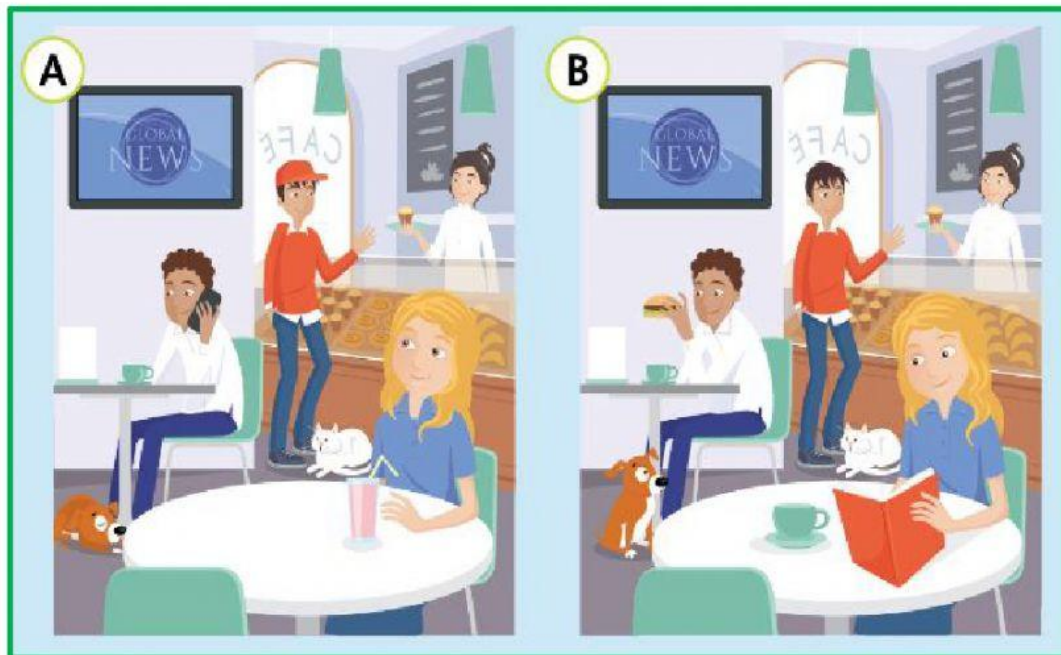
