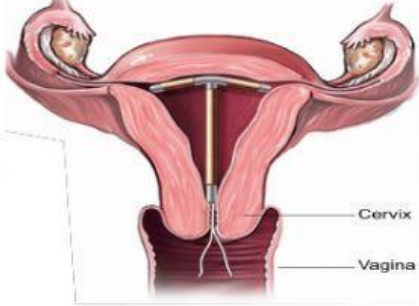


Exercise 4.6 INFERTILITY AND CONTRACEPTION
