unjustified				without good reason or explanation	I don't have a good excuse for stealing from the bakery. My actions are unjustified .
rational				able to think clearly and logically (thinking based on facts)	It's rational to read about a country before travelling there.
irrational				without reason or sense	It's irrational to travel to a dangerous country where you don't speak the language.
traditions				the transmission of customs to beliefs from generation to generation	All First Nations believed that their values and traditions were gifts from the Creator.
supernatural				relating to the spiritual world	The supernatural world includes spirits, ghosts, and magic. Witches have supernatural powers.
to curse				to use a supernatural power to harm someone or punish them	A witch can curse someone with her supernatural powers.
reverse				to go backwards	You can reverse or stop the curse if you know how to do magic.
to jinx (informal)				to create back luck by saying something good is going to happen	Bob: You are going to win the lottery! Jim: Don't say that! You are going to jinx me!
