- **Last week /year**

- **In the 20th century**
- **When I was younger**
- **When you were born**

ADVERBS USED IN THE PRESENT SIMPLE TENSE

- **Every** day/ week
- **Adverbs of frequency:** always, never, often, usually
- **Once/ Twice/ three times** a week / a month
