Birthdays in Scandinavia

Celebrations in Norway

People usually put a flag in front of the house when a child has a birthday. Norwegian kids usually invite a few of their friends for their birthday. Usually only very good friends are invited. On this day, they can eat more chocolate than usual. Chocolate cakes with chocolate candies on top are always on the table. Houses have beautifully colored paper streamers everywhere, sometimes colored as Norwegian flags. Guests often go fishing, but not for fish. They play a game where they snatch an ice-cream with their sticks. It's a tradition to sing in front of your classmates and do a little dance with your best friend.

Birthdays in Iceland

A child who has a birthday in Iceland is treated as a king or queen. They wear a crown made from flowers or leaves. The birthday person sits on a chair and the guests dance around it. Then the parents lift the chair as many times as the age of their child. They carefully choose a cake for the party. It usually has the shape of something the child likes the most - a car, for example. The thirteenth birthday is the most important because it's the end of childhood and they must behave well.
