REMEMBER + TO INFINITIVE To keep in memory what one has to do, the duty. Remember to lock the door.	REMEMBER + ING To keep in memory what has happened. I'll always remember seeing you in class.
TRY + TO INFINITIVE To make an effort to do or get something. Try to help your brother with his homework.	TRY + ING To use, do or test something to see if it is good, suitable, etc. Have you tried swimming in the ocean? It's very exciting!
