He **was** young.

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AFFIRMATIVE SENTENCES

PAST TENSE

I	was	sad.
He	was	poor.
She	was	a student.
It	was	difficult.
We	were	late.
You	were	at home.
They	were	noisy.

- Yesterday - Last month
- Last week - Last year

PRESENT TENSE

I	am	happy.
He	is	rich.
She	is	a nurse.
It	is	easy.
We	are	early.
You	are	at school.
They	are	quiet.

- Now - Right Now
- At the moment

EXAMPLES

I **was** sad yesterday, but I **am** happy at the moment.
She **was** a student last year, but she **is** a nurse now.
They **were** busy last week, but they **are** free right now.

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WAS - WERE TO BE - Past Tense

NEGATIVE			ENGLISH
I	wasn't	sad.	wasn't = was not
He	wasn't	thirsty.	
She	wasn't	a teacher.	
It	wasn't	small.	
We	weren't	late.	weren't = were not
You	weren't	at home.	
They	weren't	noisy.

Where	was	I / he / she / it	sick ...?
Why	were	we / you / they	tired ...?
When			ready ...?
- Why was he angry? - When was she nervous?			
- Where were you yesterday? - Who were those people?
