shouldn't / can / should

mustn't / must / don't have to

✿ Children \_\_\_\_\_ wear a uniform at schools in England.

have to / has to / must

✿ \_\_\_\_\_ you open the window, please? It's very hot in here.

must / can / can't

✿ I \_\_\_\_\_ come to your party. I must help my grandma.

can / must / can't

✿ I \_\_\_\_\_ tell lies to my parents.

must / mustn't / can

✿ We \_\_\_\_\_ tidy our room at the weekend.

has to / have to / don't have to

✿ The cinema is closed, so we \_\_\_\_\_ see the film.

can / must / can't

✿ It's too late. I \_\_\_\_\_ go home.

can / must / can't

✿ We \_\_\_\_\_ do anything. We have free time.

mustn't / must / don't have to

✿ He \_\_\_\_\_ to be at school. He has extra classes.

have to / has to / mustn't

✿ Entrance to the museum is free, so we \_\_\_\_\_ buy a ticket.

can't / must / don't have to

✿ John is really fit. He \_\_\_\_\_ go to the gym.

must / can't / doesn't have to
