The Chords

E MINOR, E MAJOR, A MAJOR, C MINOR, A MINOR, D MAJOR

BEFORE YOU START:

- Learn the chords progression of a song.
- Get to know which style to play:
- * Pick style: This is easy for beginners as you just strum every string in the chord.
- * Finger style: This is for advanced players as you need to know which string to hit as you play the notes of your chord progression.

NOW:

- Sit or stand up straight or and let the guitar head point about 30 degrees to the ceiling.
- Play your chords slowly and maintain the tempo.
- Increase the tempo as you get comfortable.
