Active/Passive Voice - Worksheet 1

Change each sentence from active to passive voice.

Ex. 1 SIMPLE PRESENT TENSE

Note - To change a sentence from active to passive voice in the simple present tense we use the helping verbs **am / is / are** plus the **past participle** of the main verb .

Eg. Mary **buys** potatoes on Mondays.

Potatoes **are bought** by Mary on Mondays.

4. Those fishermen catch many dolphins.

EX. 2 SIMPLE PAST TENSE

Note - To change a sentence from active to passive voice in the simple past tense we use the helping verbs **was /were** plus the **past participle** of the main verb .

Eg. Mary **bought** potatoes on Monday.

Potatoes **were bought** by Mary on Monday.

EX. 3 SIMPLE FUTURE TENSE

Note - To change a sentence from active to passive voice in the simple future tense we use the helping verbs **shall/will** plus the **past participle** of the main verb.

Eg. Mary **will buy** potatoes on Monday.

Potatoes **will be bought** by Mary on Monday.
