

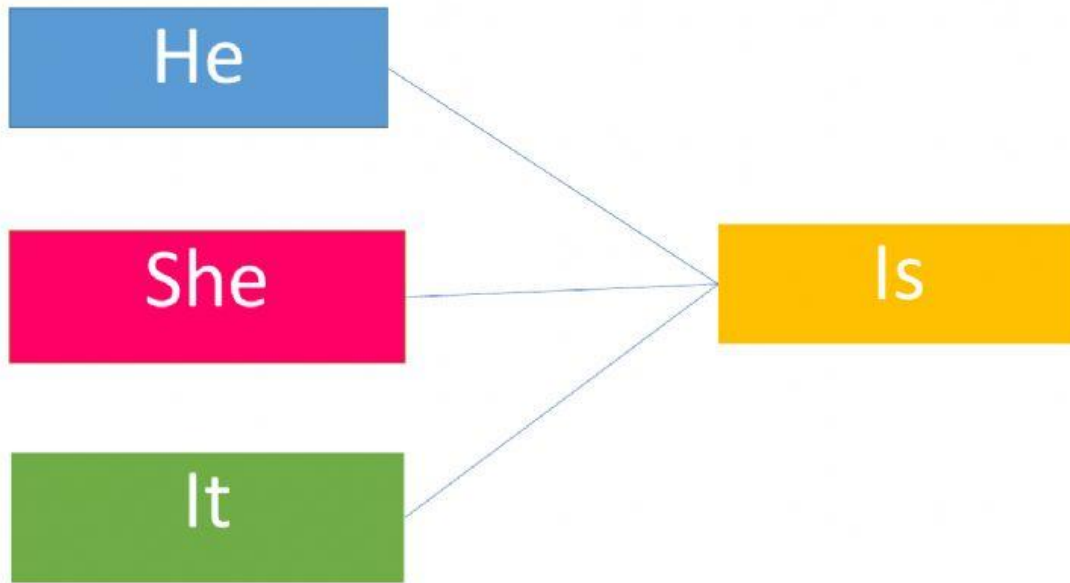
Verb to be

The verb to be in spanish means “ser o estar”. To be in a place or to be with some emotion. We can use “is”. / *El verbo “To be” en español significa ser o estar. Estar en un lugar o estar con una emoción. Podemos usar “is”.*

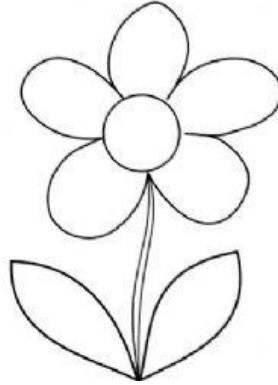
