Phrasal Verbs

- ★ Phrasal verbs are combinations of verb + auxiliaries.
- ★ Phrasal verbs are combinations of verbs + prepositions / adverbs.
- ★ **Different combinations** of verbs with other elements, will result in **different meanings**.
For example: *put away* and *put on* TRUE FALSE
- ★ In **Separable Phrasal Verbs**, the object can go in the **middle** and **after** the phrasal verb.
For example: *take your shoes off* // *take off your shoes* TRUE FALSE
- ★ In **Separable Phrasal Verbs**, when the object is a **pronoun** (*me, you, him, her, it, them, us*), it can **ONLY** appear in the **middle** of the phrasal verb.
For example: *turn it off* ✓ // *turn off it* ✗ TRUE FALSE
