

PRESENT CONTINUOUS – negative and interrogative form

Negative	Interrogative
<p>I am not (I'm not) singing. You are not (You aren't) dancing. She is not (She isn't) playing. He is not (He isn't) coming. It is not (It isn't) running. We are not (We aren't) sleeping. You are not (You aren't) sitting. They are not (They aren't) lying</p>	<p>Am I singing ? Are you dancing? Is she playing? Is he coming? Is it running? Are we sleeping? Are you sitting? Are they lying?</p>
