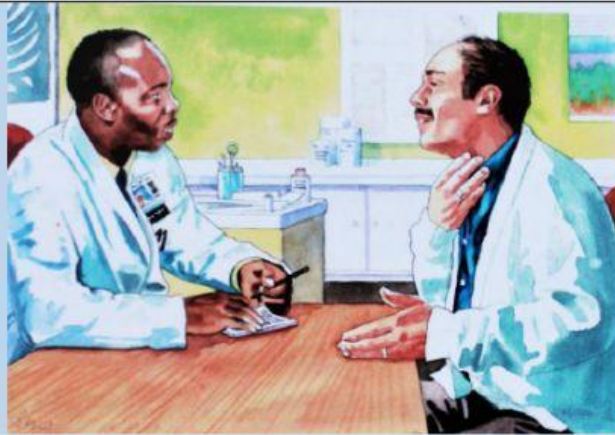


Symptoms Dialogue
