	<p><b>Family:</b> Strings</p> <p><b>Material:</b> Wooden frame and steel strings</p> <p><b>How to play:</b> Player stands by it and touches the strings with the fingers of both hands.</p> <p><b>Interesting data:</b> It has a similar sound to the piano. It is considered to be one of the world's oldest musical instruments. They have from 32 to 36 strings.</p>
	<p><b>Family:</b> Strings</p> <p><b>Material:</b> Wood</p> <p><b>How to play:</b> Player moves a bow across the strings and presses down on the neck of the instrument.</p> <p><b>Fun fact:</b> It is one of the primary instruments in classical music and orchestras.</p>
	<p><b>Family:</b> Percussion</p> <p><b>Material:</b> The frames is made of wood or metal</p> <p><b>How to play:</b> The bars are struck with a mallet to produce sound.</p> <p><b>Fun fact:</b> It is often used in elementary school musical education classes. They have from 42 to 48 wooden bars with different lengths which produce different sounds.</p>
	<p><b>Family:</b> Wind</p> <p><b>Material:</b> Brass</p> <p><b>How to play:</b> Player presses the valve and blows through the mouthpiece.</p> <p><b>Interesting data:</b> Jazz musicians often use it in their bands. This instrument was a modification of the clarinet.</p>
