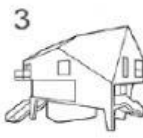

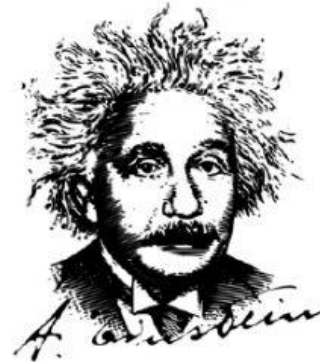
Einstein's Riddle

FOOD AROUND THE WORLD

BORSCHT



This is a soup made with beetroot, stock and other vegetables. You can drink it hot or cold. Where do you think it is from?

CROQUE MADAME



This is a fried egg and cheese sandwich. It has grated cheese on top. People usually eat it for breakfast. Where do you think it is from?

KIMCHI



This is a very spicy dish made with Chinese cabbage, onions, garlic and red pepper. Where do you think it is from?

CARBONARA



This is pasta cooked with cream sauce, eggs, bacon and olive oil. It is usually served with Parmesan cheese. Where do you think it is from?

BANGERS AND MASH



These are sausages with mashed potatoes. It has onion gravy on top. Where do you think it is from?

MEAT PIE



This is a pie with meat inside. It can have onions, mushrooms or other ingredients and tomato sauce! Where do you think it is from?

COUNTRIES AND THEIR FOOD

ITALY

Italian cuisine is known for its use of a diverse variety of pasta. It uses ingredients such as tomatoes, all kinds of meat, fish and pecorino cheese.

RUSSIA

Russian cuisine is a collection of different dishes created by peasants. It's abundant in fish, vegetables, honey and berries. Soups are a big part of Russian cuisine.

KOREA

Korean cuisine is largely based on rice, vegetables, seafood. Some common ingredients are sesame oil, bean paste, soy sauce, spicy pepper flakes and cabbage.

GREAT BRITAIN

British dishes include full breakfast, fish and chips, kidney and shepherd's pie. Their cuisine is rich and includes a lot of meat and potatoes.

AUSTRALIA

Australian cuisine is a combination of indigenous, European and Asian foods. Pies are a staple. They are so important that a pie is their national dish.

FRANCE

French cuisine has been famous since medieval times. Cheese and wine are a major part of the cuisine. A French meal usually consists of three courses.

We often forget that people in other countries eat different things from us. Rice, for example, is the staple food of more than half the world's population. In other words, it is a basic and important part of their diets. In many Western countries, such as Britain and America, bread made from wheat is the most important item of food. In many African countries a kind of corn called maize is the staple food.

Most countries have dishes that were first created there. In China such dishes as shark's fin soup and fried rice are very common. In Thailand and India people eat many different curries. They like their food hot and spicy. In England, a favourite dish is roast beef. The Italians eat pasta, which is a kind of noodle made from wheat. French food is very famous everywhere. It is often very rich.

In recent years fast food – sometimes called 'junk food' – has become very popular all over the world. It was invented in the USA and the first fast food was the hamburger, which is usually made from minced beef. Today there are restaurants and take-away places selling hamburgers in most cities of the world.

Perhaps the most international food is Chinese. There probably isn't a city anywhere that does not have at least one Chinese restaurant. This is because there are so many different dishes from so many different parts of China that there is something for everyone, whatever their favourite kind of food.
