Subject (S)– Verb (V) Agreement

SV agreement refers to the relationship between the subject and predicate of the sentence. Subjects and verbs must always agree in number and tense.

Number

- Singular subject takes singular verb
- Plural subject takes plural verb

Example:

- 1) **Water** keeps us healthy.
- 2) When **we** exercise regularly, we will fit and be healthy.
- 3) **It** is recommended to drink at least eight glasses of water per day.
- 4) **He** walks around the lake every morning.
- 5) **Kamini** is at the school.
- 6) **You** sing like a professional.
- 7) **I** like to play badminton.
- 8) **They** have three children.
- 9) **We** do not know the answers for the comprehension questions.
- 10) **The animals** are placed in the zoo.
- 11) **Everyone** has to be present in the meeting.
- 12) **Somebody** has taken her diary.
- 13) **Nobody** is allowed to leave the hall.
- 14) **The team** practises hard before their final match.
- 15) **The family** has a lot of pets.

Note:

- a) Although I and You are singular, they take plural forms of verb.
- b) Indefinite pronouns like anyone, someone, everyone, somebody, no one, and nobody are always singular subjects, so they take plural verb.
- c) Collective nouns generally is singular, so they take singular verb.
