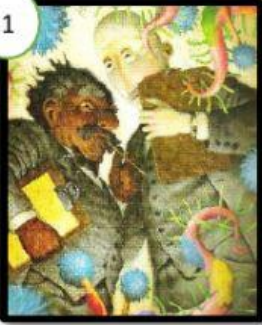


A Bad Case of Stripes

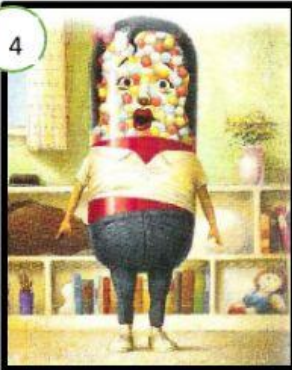
B. What are the kids doing? (CALL out shapes and colors)

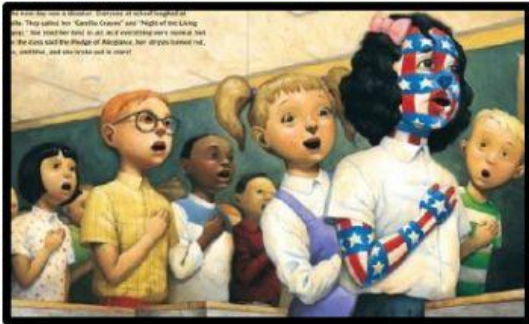
D. What are the doctors doing? (WHISPER about Camilla's bad case of stripes)

B. Camilla is speaking to her new friend, Marie. She is telling her about the strange problem she has. Complete what Camilla says with the correct form of the verbs between brackets.



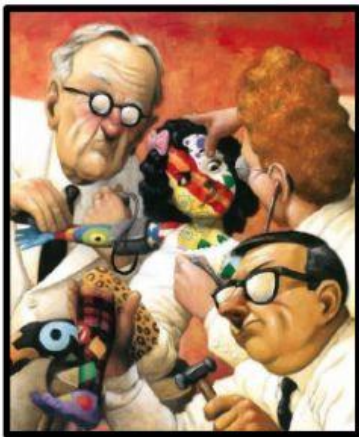
