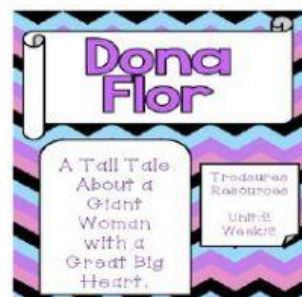


"DONA FLOR" (by Pat Mora)
